



I am unable to get the information from Bud again because he is in the hospital recovering from surgery. Please send your prayers and good intentions to Bud for a speedy recovery.



# Chancellor's Challenge

Maybe you think of a crap table and if a number SEVEN is rolled on a crap ta-



The number SEVEN in the movies reminds me of the hit move `The Magnificent Seven' where the good guys got the best of the bad guys.

On the spiritual side there are SEVEN Corporal Works of Mercy for us to remember to physically help our fellow man. They are: to feed the hungry, to give drink to the

thirsty, to clothe the naked, to visit the imprisoned, to shelter the homeless, to visit the sick and to bury the dead.

But the devil has on his side the SEVEN Deadly Sins to make us destroy those works of mercy. They are Pride, Envy, Anger, Gluttony, Lust, Sloth, and Avarice. Stay away from those devil SEVENS.

I also noticed that during my visit to Blessed Sacrament yesterday that there are SEVEN chairs in the Eucharistic Chapel. I think that there are many Knights who declined to sign up for adoration for many reasons, maybe because it is a commitment for a certain time of day and day of the week. Or maybe they didn't sign up because of a deep dislike of regimentation. Maybe some fear that they will fail to keep the commitment and if they have to give up later they will be embarrassed.

For whatever reason some Knights have not committed. Let me explain to all that this is not a closed group. You are allowed to visit Jesus even if you did not sign up.

For those that did not sign up, the next time you hear or see the words Perpetual Adoration I challenge you to make a visit soon. Use one of those SEVEN chairs in that quiet setting for just a moment. And this can be

anytime, day or night. Remember that Jesus is waiting to
see you on His
twenty-four hour schedule and He allows more
than one appointment at a
time. Your commitment will
be only to Him.

Take a chance and roll the dice! You will always be a winner because there are no losers at His table. And the odds are better than any game. I'll bet that if you make one visit you won't stop at one.

## Duties of the Elected Officers

I am printing the duties for each office so those who are interested will know what the offices are about. There will be no elections for the Board of Trustees because Hector Raymond and George Williams will remain on the board and the Past Grand Knight will be the Three Year Trustee.

# OFFICERS

The <u>Grand Knight</u> shall: Preside over meetings; appoint committees, countersign orders drawn by the financial secretary for payment of money; countersign checks; read vouchers; read notices relative to the Fourth Degree; and perform other duties as the Order may impose; and act as Chaplain in the Chaplain's absence.

The <u>Deputy Grand Knight</u> shall: Preside in the absence of the Grand Knight and execute all duties of said Grand Knight.

The Chancellor shall: Assist the Grand Knight and the Deputy Grand Knight in the performance of their duties; is charged with the total participation of the membership in the activities of the council; shall exercise a special interest in new members and those members that are sick or in distress; and perform other duties as the Grand Knight directs.

The <u>Recorder</u> shall: Keep a true and accurate record of the doings of his council upon books approved by the Board of Directors and furnished by the Supreme Secretary at the expense of the council; conduct all correspondence of the council and perform all duties as the council may direct.

The <u>Treasurer</u> shall: Be the custodian of the funds; receive all monies from the Financial Secretary and give a written receipt for same, specifying the funds to which the same shall be credited; monies received shall be deposited by said Treasurer to the credit of the Council and obtain vouchers of said deposits and those vouchers delivered to the Grand Knight.

The <u>Lecturer</u> shall: Endeavor to devise means to entertain his council at meetings and perform duties as his council may direct.

The Advocate shall: Be the attorney of the council in case of a trial and investigation of any matter whatsoever of interest of the council.

The <u>Warden</u> shall: Be present at all meetings and the opening of the same. He shall have charge of the council property and keep same in proper condition for meetings (except monies and account books); he shall instruct his guards in their duties.

The <u>Guards</u> shall: The <u>Inside</u>
<u>Guard</u> shall attend the entrance to the council chamber, through the inner door; the <u>Outside Guard</u> through the entrance through the

outer door; and each shall perform other duties as may be imposed by the council.

The Board of Trustees shall: Consist of the Grand Knight and three members to be elected by the council. The Grand Knight shall be the chairman. At the first election of a new council there will be one to hold office for one year, one for two years, and one for three years. Thereafter there will be one three year trustee to be elected. The Trustees shall have supervision of all the financial business of the council: shall audit all the accounts of the Financial Secretary and treasurer, and in January and July report thereon to their council, State Deputy, District Deputy and Supreme Council. They shall perform such other duties as their council or the District Deputy or the officers of the Order may direct. In our case the Two Year Trustee will become the One Year Trustee; the Three Year Trustee will become the Two Year Trustee, and the Past Grand Knight will become the Three year Trustee for the Year 2000-2001. Therefore there will be no elections for the Trustee positions this year.
